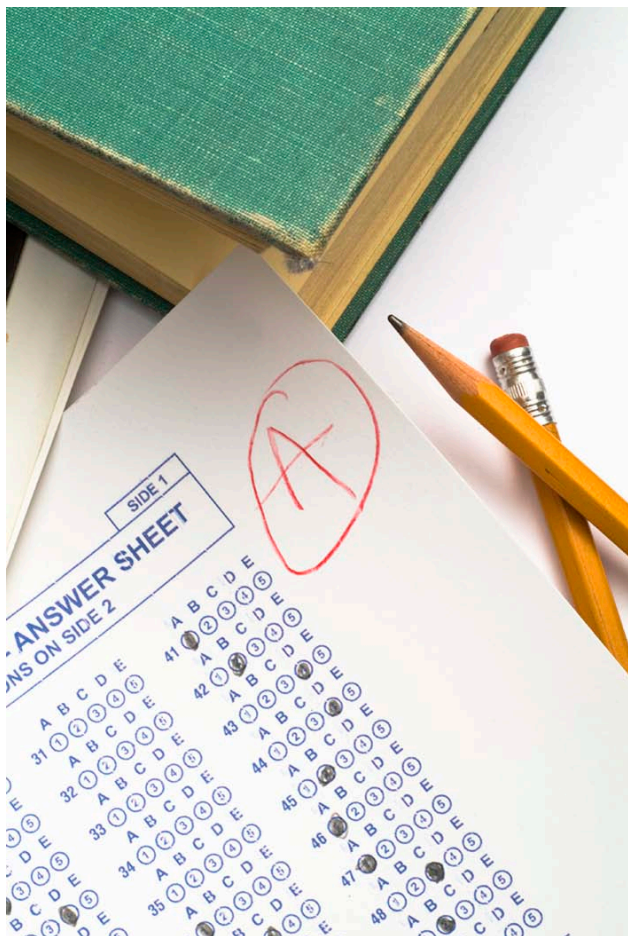

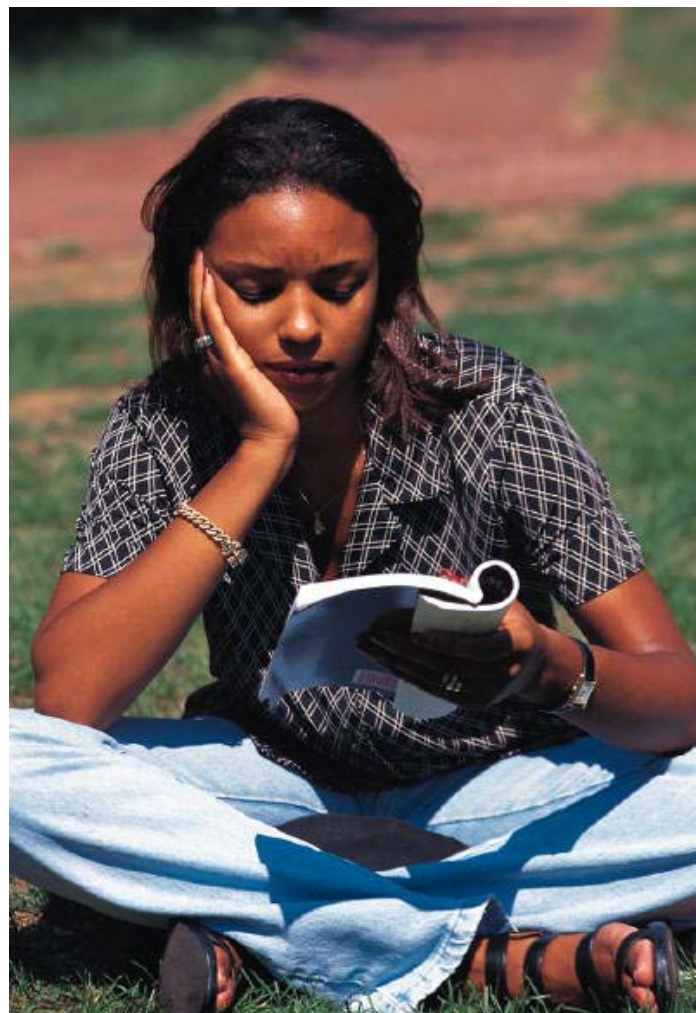

White House Task Force on Childhood Obesity

Highlights from the recommendations:

Women to be at a healthy weight at conception and avoid excess weight gain during pregnancy.

Breastfeeding is encouraged: Studies show breastfed babies are 22 percent less likely to become obese.

Smaller restaurant portions and posting of calorie information.

Schools to serve more fruits in lunches and vending machines. Promote more children to participate in the school lunch program and update nutrition standards.

Increase physical activity in schools

Pediatricians to check patients' body mass index
